




On Thursday, we had an Escape Room. Anyone could participate!





sgiving Day

Thanksgiving - a holiday celebrated in the United States on the fourth Thursday of November, and in Canada on the second Monday of October, as a commemoration of the first harvest festival of the inhabitants of the Plymouth Colony in 1621. It was then that the refugees from England were to organize a dinner to thank God for surviving this difficult journey and for the abundant harvest. Thanksgiving Day was declared a national holiday by President Abraham Lincoln in 1863, and the specific date was set by Franklin Delano Roosevelt. Today is one of the most important day in every American's calendar.

- > Americans eat approximately 46 million turkeys during Thanksgiving
- > Up to 95% of Americans celebrate the holiday Thanksgiving, and 88% serve the famous turkey during family dinner
- > After dinner, most Americans sit down as a family to watch an American football match

Thanksgiving dishes

Traditional dishes are prepared for Thanksgiving. In addition to the stuffed turkey, cranberry and roast sauce cannot be missing on the holiday table. Lunch is usually served with mashed potatoes (whipped with milk and butter), corn and cornbread. The additions may include green beans or sweet potato.

For dessert, pumpkin pie or pecan pie is served. Apple pie is also often served, necessarily accompanied by apple cider.




